UnFound Accelerator – application guidance

Turn your pioneering idea into a successful platform co-op business

Introduction

<u>The UnFound Accelerator</u> is a business support programme for platform coops.

The UnFound Accelerator is made possible by The Co-operative Bank, which is also providing £10,000 in prize money to be distributed among the most successful teams.

Key dates

Applications are now open for the 2023 UnFound Accelerator. The deadline is midnight 5 March.

The 2023 edition will start on 26 April 2023 and is composed of the following parts:

- An intensive 10-week programme of masterclasses from 26 April 2022 to 28 June 2023
- A pitch event on 11 July 2023 (TBC)
- One-to-one support to be arranged on the teams' own time from July to November 2023
- An aftercare package for teams that successfully complete the accelerator

What is a platform co-op?

A platform co-operative is a democratically owned and controlled business that uses an online platform or mobile app to trade, connect people and pool resources or data.

It is built on co-operative principles and values which ensure the platform business:

- Truly responds to the needs of its community
- Embeds equity and social purpose from day one
- is not controlled by external profit-driven investors.

Platform co-ops are a relatively new phenomenon, with pioneering entrepreneurs setting up businesses in a wide range of sectors across the globe. You can find more information at www.unfound.coop and via the Platform Co-op Consortium.

About the UnFound Accelerator

What is the UnFound Accelerator?

The UnFound Accelerator is a business support programme for teams of entrepreneurs at the early stage of setting up their platform co-operative businesses. Teams will accompany each other in the exciting journey of turning their pioneering ideas into concrete business solutions.

Successful applicants will be provided with guidance and support to set the foundations of their platform business through Co-operatives UK's extensive network of experts, including CoTech and others.

Teams that complete the Accelerator will get the chance to pitch their business idea to access funding and support at an event on 11 July 2023 (TBC), towards which the Co-operative Bank has contributed a £10,000 prize pot.

Is the UnFound Accelerator right for me?

The UnFound Accelerator is for founding teams (of at least 2 people) that have a clear and compelling idea for a platform co-operative and need support to launch their business.

The UnFound Accelerator is for teams:

- Ready to transform their idea into a viable business
- Who believe the co-operative model is right for their platform business for guidance see "Is a co-op right for me?"
- Looking to register as a co-operative business by the end of 2023.

We expect applications to reference at least two individuals who are part of the team and we will prioritise ideas that are developed and ready to incorporate in 2023 or that are already incorporated.

Programme content

Support participants receive

The UnFound Accelerator will provide a mix of expert guidance and development support across four interconnected business areas:

- Co-operative structures and ways of working
- Product development
- Business planning and strategy
- Brand and marketing

What participants leave with

- Expert guidance on the articles (or rules) to use to incorporate as a co-operative business
- A pitch presenting their business case and brand
- A business plan and a defined funding runway
- A marketing plan for the first steps of their fundraising journey
- A tested prototype and a roadmap to develop their platform

Programme structure

The UnFound Accelerator will lead a cohort of 6-12 teams through an intensive 10-week business development programme followed by tailored one-to-one support.

The main programme

The main programme will run from 26 April to 28 June 2023 and will consist of:

- 10 full day Masterclasses, held online every Wednesday from 10am to 4pm (with breaks).
- Exercises to be completed independently by teams in between the weekly sessions, which should take teams between 2-4 hours to complete

Optional activities

During the year teams will also be offered the following optional activities:

- 9 hours of one-to-one per team with up to three different experts on specific topics or other platform co-op founders
- Fortnightly check-ins: A regular call with the UnFound programme manager to discuss the team's specific challenges and provide guidance

The pitch event

Teams that successfully complete the Masterclasses will have the opportunity to pitch their business idea at an online public event on 11 July 2023 (TBC) attended by potential investors, representatives from leading co-operatives and industry experts. Read about the 2022 pitch event

Teams may use the pitch to request specific support, and the audience will be given the opportunity to respond to their requests, with funds, resources or support in kind.

The Co-operative Bank has contributed £10,000 towards a prize fund that will be allocated to the teams based on the vote of the audience.

Aftercare

All teams can access free business banking from The Co-operative Bank.

The best performing teams will be awarded an aftercare package composed of:

- Free registration fee for co-ops that incorporate within the calendar year
- A case-study page on Co-operatives UK's website
- Visibility through Co-operatives UK's media channels

Your commitment

• A minimum of one member from each participating team must be able to attend each

Masterclass

• There is no fee to participate in the UnFound Accelerator however, participating teams will be required to have the appropriate equipment and set-up to participate (a computer with a functioning microphone and camera and an internet connection)

Eligibility criteria

Eligibility

In order to be able to apply for the UnFound Accelerator you must meet the following criteria:

- You intend to incorporate your platform co-operative in the UK
- You are a team of at least two members
- At least one member is resident in the UK
- All team members participating in the Accelerator are 18 or older

Availability

- If shortlisted, at least one team member must be available to attend an online interview between 27-30 March 2023. An interview will be compulsory for the shortlisted teams and we will notify you a couple of days in advance
- If accepted on the Accelerator, at least one team member (even on a rotational basis) must be able to attend all the Masterclasses. Masterclasses will take place online each Wednesday from 10 am-5pm (with breaks) from Wednesday 26 April 2023 to Wednesday 28 June 2023
- If accepted on the Accelerator, at least one team member must be available to attend and present at the pitch event (11 July TBC)

Assessment criteria

If you are eligible to apply, your applications will be evaluated using the below assessment criteria.

Whilst your team does not need to satisfy all criteria, they will guide us in our selection process, so do consider them when completing your application:

1. Is it a platform co-op?

We will only accept business ideas that fit our definition of a platform co-operative.

2. Purpose

We are looking for ideas where the <u>co-operative model</u> is central to delivering the purpose of the business. Ensure you explain how the co-operative model makes a real difference to the people that use the platform.

3. Potential impact

We are particularly interested in supporting platform co-ops that address some of the most pressing challenges of our times. If your platform idea aims to have a broader impact than to simply serve its users, please explain how, and the vision you have for its impact to scale.

4. **Team**

We will be looking at the composition of your team and the skills, experience and network that each of your members will bring to the business, as well as what motivates each of you to set it up. The most successful co-ops are those that respond directly to the needs of their members, so we expect at least one of your members to be embedded or well connected to the community you wish to serve.

5. Commitment

We are looking for teams that are committed to incorporating as a co-operative by the end of 2023 and that will truly benefit from the support provided.

6. Equity, diversity and inclusion

We will be looking at how both your team composition and your platform idea embed principles of equity, diversity and inclusion.

Application process

To apply please fill in the online application form by midnight 5 March 2023.

You should <u>read through the application questions</u> before applying. We advise you to prepare your responses in advance on a separate document and then copy/paste your responses into the form. Please note that we ask for information from each team member so we advise you to co-ordinate all contributions in advance.

Accelerator FAQs

Below are some of the questions we have received. We will update this page as new questions come in.

About the tech

Do I need to know how to code to apply?

No, it is not a requirement.

We already have an MVP (Minimal Viable Product), can we still apply?

Yes, do apply or book a call with us beforehand to discuss your specific case.

The technology for my platform co-op idea exists already and I can use it under a licence agreement, but I would still like to have guidance on how to set up the business. Can I still apply for the UnFound Accelerator?

Yes, do apply. However, please keep in mind that part of the Accelerator will be dedicated to developing your product. If you don't think you would benefit from this type of support, you might want to consider applying to The Hive programme instead.

Our platform is a voice application, would this meet the criteria?

Yes, a platform co-op does not have to include a visual interface.

Does the definition of 'online' include internet alternatives such as IoT, LoRaWAN and Solid networks?

It depends on what you are looking to develop and the type of support you are looking from us, so do get in touch if you want more guidance. Generally speaking, setting up a co-op to share or build infrastructure would not qualify for the UnFound Accelerator; but, if alongside that you are planning to design a platform to give access to the infrastructure or to gather data from it, you would still qualify.

Will CoTech be providing a platform ready to white-label to other co-op users?

No. CoTech will be facilitating sessions to help you develop your own product, be it using off-theshelf technology, or building your own.

About your team

Why do there have to be at least two team members?

A co-operative needs to be set up with a minimum of two people – depending on the legal form – as a co-operative is a form of organisation that involves co-operation among people or organisations.

The UnFound Accelerator is aimed at teams that are looking at incorporating by the end of 2023, so we will be giving priority to applicants that already have a team in place. However we

acknowledge that this might not be the case for everyone, so we are open to applications where not all the team members are already committed to being a member of the co-operative.

Who qualifies as a team member?

A team member can be someone who is invested and committed to the platform co-op and ready to become a founding member, but it could also be a potential user of the platform, or simply someone who supports the idea but is not committed to becoming a member.

Do all members of the team need to attend every Masterclass?

No only one member needs to attend and it doesn't have to always be the same person.

About your business

We are not sure what 'incorporating' involves, so we cannot commit to incorporating by June 2023. Can we still apply?

Yes, no one will be expected to incorporate before they are ready to. The UnFound Accelerator will offer support in understanding what it means to incorporate and how to. However, we ask you to indicate your intentions to do so, as we want the Accelerator to benefit those that are in most need of our support now as they are looking to set up their business soon.

We are already incorporated, does this mean we don't count as an early-stage co-op?

You are welcome to apply even if you are already an incorporated entity, whether you have incorporated as a co-op or not. By "early-stage" we mean businesses that are not already trading, or if they are, most of their trading is not happening through a platform.

About our support programmes

I applied for the previous edition of the UnFound Accelerator and my application was not successful, can I apply again?

Yes, you may still apply, however, we will expect you to demonstrate some progress on your business idea.

I have already received support via the Platform Co-ops Now course, can I still apply?

Yes, you may still apply, however, please indicate the progress (or not) you have made since, so we can evaluate if you will benefit from the Accelerator.

I have already received support via The Hive, can I still apply?

It will depend on what type of support you have received and when. Please contact us via unfound@uk.coop so we can discuss this together, or indicate the support received in the application.

I am about to receive the support that I have been awarded via The Hive, can I still apply?

Please contact us via <u>unfound@uk.coop</u> to discuss this further as it will depend on your specific case.



I have applied to Co-operatives UK's Business Support programme for start-ups and I am still waiting for the outcome, can I apply to the UnFound Accelerator while I'm waiting for a response?
